All racers must have full medical insurance with cover for Alpine ski racing

Equipment

Competitors and coaches are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that equipment, including ski length and radius, conforms to discipline specifications. Properly fitted back supports are recommended. Participants must wear approved crash helmets for all disciplines. **Bairns may not wear catsuits.**

Competition Notes/continued

Eligibility

All U14 and U16 racers should be registered with the British Alpine Seeding System (BASS) for the 2016/17 season. We will be using the 2017-1 BASS seedlist which will be issued at the beginning of December 2016. If you are not on this list you will be deemed to be unseeded - so please check. The organising committee reserves the right to accept non registered racers at their discretion. Preference will be given to BASS registered racers.

Competitors in the Bairns U10/U12 categories must be registered with their Home Nation Governing Body or submit a signed *British Snowsports Athlete Declaration Form* (see above) **and** proof of public liability insurance, which includes cover for racing with the race entry. Proof of membership of an HNGB affiliated club will cover this.

Photographs

Photographers may be present on the hill. If you object to photographs of yourself or child to be taken please inform the Chief of Race prior to the entry closing date.

Entries

Entries should be made on the entry form below and must be received, with payment, by the Championships Secretary by **Thursday 15th December 2016**. Should the race be oversubscribed then entries will be taken on a first come basis. For fees, see above. Late entries may be considered but will incur an additional late entry fee of £50 for the series.

Refunds

Once a race entry has been accepted, if the races are cancelled the organisers will endeavour to refund as much of the entry fee as they can, after covering fixed costs and expenses.

Acceptance and Bulletin

Acceptance lists will be posted on Britski shortly after the 15th December 2016. A race bulletin will also be emailed to entrants with a schedule for the team captains' meetings and each day's racing in good time before the New Year.

Insurance

All competitors **MUST** have insurance cover for both ski racing **and** helicopter recovery.
