Children's Winter Programme

The Children's Winter Season programme, commencing 11/12/2021, is 81 'Schengen days', and 108 days in total.

The price for individual blocks of training is shown on the above table **. There is a one-off registration fee of £75 applicable to all programmes.

If booking for the whole of the Winter Season, excluding Andorra, the fee is reduced to $\pm 11,600$ **

If booking for the whole of the Winter Season, including Andorra, the fee is £15,700** #

FIS Winter Season Programme

The Winter season programme, commencing 27th November 2021, is 90 days in the Schengen area and the total Winter programme is 115 days, excluding the trip to the USA.

The price for individual blocks of training is shown on the above table. There is a one-off Registration Fee of £75 applicable to all programmes.

If booking for the whole of the Winter Season programme, excluding Andorra and the USA, the fee is £12,900**.

If booking for the whole of the Winter Season, including Andorra but excluding the USA, the fee is £16,500**.

** There is a £50 per night supplement for races away from base.

Payment

N.B. We strongly advise that you have insurance that provides cover for cancellation or curtailment.

The programme shown is booked on an individual basis up to the start of the Winter Schedule (11/12/2021 for Children and 27/11/21 for FIS). During August/September, we will contact you to confirm your planned dates for the Winter Season. An invoice will be sent to you based upon the dates that you have chosen or the full programme. Along with the invoice, we will provide a payment plan that ensures payment is received for the upcoming period at least 28 days in advance. Please also see 'Winter Sports Foundation' information below as this can be a way of raising additional funding.

Payment can be made by bank transfer (details on the invoice) or by credit/debit card (please contact the office to arrange this).

Races Away From Base Location

There is a £50 per night supplement for races away from the base location. This applies to both FIS and Children's programmes.

Airport transfers

Certain airport transfers (main dates around Christmas/New Year, Anglo Scottish/ English Championships/British Championships) are included in the residential package.

All other airport transfers outside of the published dates/times/airports are subject to an individual arrangement/price.

Lift Passes

The residential programme fee includes a local lift pass for the duration of the stay.

Outliers are responsible for the organisation/payment of their own passes both at base or races away from home, except for FIS races where the coach is required to purchase them at the Coach meeting the night before the race (English and British Championships).

Race Entry

Race entry remains the responsibility of parents/athletes, except for non-UK FIS races, where coaches will make the entries. Depending if GBSnowsport are involved in the arrangements for the non-UK FIS races, parents may receive an invoice at the end of the season from them, for handling the entries.



Schengen Arrangements

Please see our Schengen Area FAQ's for more detailed information.

As much as possible, our programme has been designed to account for the 90 days stay in 180 restriction in countries inside the Schengen area. All time spent in the Schengen area counts towards the limit, regardless as to the reason and so things such as family holidays should be included when calculating. Training in the block highlighted in yellow will take place outside of the Schengen area and will not count towards the 90 days restriction. The link below is a useful calculator to give an indication to the use of your allowance. It is only a tool to assist in planning and you should still check that it is accurate before making a commitment.

Passports and GHIC

It is the responsibility of the parent (or the athlete if they are 18 or over) that athletes have both a passport that has 6 months left before expiration and the new GHIC card (replacement for the EHIC card and available to order online for UK citizens) when at camps held abroad.

Coaching Ratios

We aim to work on a coaching ratio of 1 coach to 6 athletes. For Minis, we aim to have a lower athlete to coach ratio.

<u>Kit</u>

We do not require athletes to purchase any BSA kit to attend training with us. We haven order for grey ski jackets and pink and green shell jackets in place and this should be available before the start of the winter season.

Our Commitment to you:

At the British Ski Academy, we undertake to do our utmost to foster your racer's development in the sport of Alpine ski racing, to support their educational programme and to provide for their welfare.

Terms & Conditions - Winter Season Programme

The terms and conditions set out here, together with your invoice, comprise the agreement between you and the British Ski Academy.

- 1. Upon receipt of a request for specific dates to attend The British Ski Academy and a completed Registration Form, we will confirm your booking with an invoice.
- A copy of the BSA 'Athlete's Code of Conduct' and' Disciplinary Procedure' is available on our website. Attendance at our camps constitutes an agreement to the expected standards of behaviour and possible consequences if they are not met as outlined in these documents.
- 3. Appropriate alpine ski race training/race medical/accident/travel insurance is mandatory for the duration of your trip.
- 4. In the event of cancellation or curtailment of a booking as a result of UK or host country Government advice/restrictions, Foreign and commonwealth office advice, or COVID related guidance, a minimum refund of 60% of fees paid for the cancelled/curtailed period will be made to you. If BSA obtain a full refund from the relevant service provider(s) e.g. lift company, hotel provider etc., this will be passed to you upon receipt. We strongly recommend you take out cancellation/curtailment insurance.
- 5. BSA will not be responsible for cancellation or curtailment of a booking as a result of the inability to ski because of (i) weather conditions, (ii) restrictions imposed by the resort / local government such as lift closures. BSA will attempt to arrange alternative provision and you will be advised of any additional costs before accepting the alternative. Any additional costs will be your responsibility.
- 6. The British Ski Academy will not be responsible for any additional costs/charges that there may be as a result of a change in arrangements, planning etc. that are related to any incidents/causes that are outside of BSA's control e.g. additional hotel or transport costs, should there be a need to quarantine/isolate or to make alternative travel arrangements.
- 7. Full instalment payment is due 28 days before the start of the booking. If the booking is less than 28 days before the planned arrival date, full payment must be received before arrival.
- 8. It is the responsibility of the parent (or athlete if they are 18 or over) to ensure that they have completed all necessary travel documentation and complied with all legislation, regulations and testing, particularly in relation to Schengen Visa/area limitations, passport validity requirements and COVID 19.
- If you want to cancel your booking, you must tell us immediately by email to <u>tracy@britskiacad.org.uk</u>. If you cancel, you will be liable to pay the cancellation charges set out in the table below. Charges depend on the date when we receive your cancellation.
