





# British Ski Academy Firpark Slalom Invitation Sunday 11th July 2021

# **Invitation & Information**

BSA invites registered (U10 – Master) and non-registered (U10/12) racers to compete in the BSA Seeded Slalom to be held at Firpark Snowsport centre on the weekend of Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

The event is organised by the British Ski Academy. We would like to thank the management and staff of Firpark Snowsport Centre, without whom the race would not be possible. We are very excited to be able to run the first race back at Firpark, however the race format will look different to pre-COVID. With the help of Firpark Snow Centre and Clackmannanshire Council, we have put together a day of races that aim to be as safe, efficient, and importantly, as much fun as possible.

Please make sure that you read the document carefully and understand the changes that have been made to comply with current regulations and safety measures. We hope you understand and appreciate the procedures/set up that have been created; our number one priority is safety for all concerned. More detailed information on groups and timings will be released once entries have closed.

#### **Entry**

- Entry fee for this event is £28.
- Online entry is available at https://www.britskiacad.org.uk/events/2021-07/bsa-firpark-race-11-july
- Entries will open on Wednesday 16th June at 7pm.
- Entries will close 7pm Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
- Late entries will not be accepted.
- After the entry system closes, the running order will be determined, and bib numbers allocated. A full acceptance list and event timetable will be published one the BSA website, as well as GBSKI.com and on social media. This will also show the earliest onsite arrival time for each group, with a programme for each round of races and the latest time for leaving site.
- Should the race become full before entry closes, entry will be based on 'First Come, First Served'.
- The Race Secretary has the final decision on any issues around entry.

- The main event is open to registered racers in all age categories from U10 to Masters.
- Racers born in 2009 and older must have current membership/registration of their Home Nation (SnowsportEngland, Scotland or Wales). To check membership status, go to <a href="http://www.gbski.com/competitors.php">http://www.gbski.com/competitors.php</a> where the 'Season' column will show the last year membership was paid this should be 2021.
- To encourage young racers, we will run a separate race for minis out with the seed points.
- Minimum age is 8 years entrant must be 8 or over on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2021.
- Athletes born 2014 and later are not eligible to enter.
- Please note the new season 2021/22 age categories apply:

# Format for the day

- Check-in is at the bottom of the slope. Once a competitor has checked in, the guardian must leave the area.
- After bib collection, there will be a warm-up period of 25 minutes, which will take place on a section of slope to be confirmed and will consist of space for free skiing. This will likely be the skiers left of the slope.
- No external coaches are allowed onto the slope.
- Open practice can only take place within your timetabled period and wearing your bib that must be visible.
- Each group of racers will be invited to course inspect for one run at their scheduled time for a period of 10 minutes. Normal course inspection rules will apply, with bibs to be always worn and visible. Racers are asked to distance as much as possible during inspection.
- Following course inspection, there will be a period of 5 minutes to enable the group to get to the start.
- In bib order, each group will race both (three for minis) race runs consecutively, with overall times recorded by the race organisers.
- After completing their race runs, racers will be required to leave the slope as soon as possible, following a one-way system, making space for subsequent groups of racers who will be arriving for their allocated time slot.
- Racers may carry skis to the top between runs and will be able to do a run after their timed runs to get any equipment at the top.
- No-one other than racers may be in the start area at any time.
- A limit of 22 people inside at the fencing at any one time will apply throughout the day.

Unfortunately, there will be no official prize giving on the day but will make sure that medallists are recognised and awarded their prize.

#### Refunds

Should you need to withdraw from the event prior to 11<sup>th</sup> July due to COVID complications, a refund of 50% per competitor will be available.

If the whole race must be cancelled due to COVID-19 restrictions, full entry fees will be refunded.

There will be no refunds available for any other reasons.

### **Photography**

Photographers will be present during the event. If you do not wish to be photographed or filmed, or for your image to be used for promotional purposes, please inform the race secretary.
