

Artemis Anglo Scottish Cup and British Ski Academy Championships 2018 Preliminary Programme

08 Aug 2017

The ASC will be held in the resort of Crevacol, Italy with four days of racing for racers born 2002 to 2005 and three days of racing for Children born 2006 to 2000. U14/U16s will have 2 x giant slalom and 2 x slalom. Bairns (U10/U12) will have a stubby slalom, combi and giant slalom. Prizes will be awarded for each day's event and medals to 5th place for girls and boys in all four separate age categories: U10, U12, U14 and U16. Provisional programme:

Race & Equipment Rules

These championships will be run under International Competition Rules (ICR) as amended by British rules (BCR) as of October 2016. It is the competitors and coaches responsibility to make sure that they are aware of these.

All racers must have full medical insurance with cover for Alpine ski racing

Equipment

Competitors and coaches are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that equipment, including ski length and radius, conforms to discipline specifications. Properly fitted back supports are recommended. Participants must wear approved crash helmets for all disciplines. **Bairns may not wear catsuits.**

Eligibility

All U14 and U16 racers should be registered with the British Alpine Seeding System (BASS) for the 2017/18 season. We will be using the 2018-1 BASS seedlist which will be issued at the beginning of December 2017. **If you are not on this list you will be deemed to be unseeded** - so please check. The organising committee reserves the right to accept non registered racers at their discretion. Preference will be given to BASS registered racers. →

Competition Notes/ continued

Eligibility

Competitors in the Bairsns U10/U12 categories must be registered with their Home Nation Governing Body or submit proof of public liability insurance, which includes cover for racing with the race entry. Proof of membership of an HNGB affiliated club will cover this. **And**, unless race entry made online, they must also submit a signed *British Snowsports Athlete Declaration Form* (see above).

Photographs

Photographers may be present on the hill. If you object to photographs of yourself or child to be taken please inform the Chief of Race prior to the entry closing date.

Entries

Entries should be made on the entry form below and must be received, with payment, by the Championships Secretary by **Thursday 14th December 2017**. Should the race be oversubscribed then entries will be taken on a first come basis. For fees, see above. Late entries may be considered but will incur an additional late entry fee of £50 for the series.

Refunds

Once a race entry has been accepted, if the races are cancelled the organisers will endeavour to refund as much of the entry fee as they can, after covering fixed costs and expenses.

Acceptance and Bulletin

Acceptance lists will be posted on Britski shortly after the 15th December 2017. A race bulletin will also be emailed to entrants with a schedule for the team captains' meetings and each day's racing in good time before the New Year.

Insurance

All competitors **MUST** have insurance cover for both ski racing **and** helicopter recovery.
