British national seeded (BASS) races for U18, U16, U14, and unseeded races for U12, U10 will be run under BCR (FIS ICR as amended by GBS). Slalom for U12/U10 will be run through stubby gates. Rules for all competitions and disciplines can be found at gbski.com/rules

Individual prizes will be awarded in all age categories, male and female.

For the British Interschool Ski Championships the Schools Cup will be awarded on a points basis from each school's best two results each day in any category.

1st = 10 points, 2nd = 7 points, 3rd = 5 points, 4th = 3 points, 5th = 2 points, 6th = 1 point

Team Captains' Meetings

The first TCM will take place at 1800 on 12th March at the British Ski Academy race office and base: Hotel Panoramique, Frazione Pont D'Avisod, 90, 11010 Sarre AO, Italy. There will be the opportunity to log in to the first TCM by Zoom.

Bibs will be available at the race office and also from the start area of each day's event. Race bibs for all events will be collected at the end of the second run in the finish area. Bibs not returned after the race will result in a £80 penalty to the guardian of the athlete. As soon as possible after each day's racing we will hold the TCM inside the Hermitage Restaurant. After Tuesday's and Thursday's races we will hold an award ceremony outside the Hermitage for the British Interschools and BSA Champs respectively.

Race Entry Details

All British competitors must either be registered for BASS seeding with their respective Home Nation (Snowsport Scotland, England or Wales) or have an Athlete's Declaration signed by a parent or guardian.

All competitors must have a current insurance policy that covers them for ski racing. The Organising Committee may require proof of insurance such as a valid governing body race licence or an independent certificate of insurance. **No insurance = No Racing**

All entries should be made via the official online entry system on www.britskiacad.org.uk
Fees = £60 per day / £200 for all four days.

An Entry List will be published on www.gbski.com. Bulletins will be circulated via GBSki, BSA social media pages and, from 08 March, an event WhatsApp group.

Online entries will close on 28.02.2023

Refunds

In the case of withdrawal from any event due to injury (prior to the championships) refunds will be available on production of a doctor's letter. Refunds will not be available for adverse weather or snow conditions that result in the cancellation of races. The organisers & hill team will do their utmost to ensure that all of the races are run in full.

Volunteers and Support

We require a small amount of help from parents & supporters in resort during the races with roles such as gate judging and marshalling. Whilst we have a team travelling from the UK for the race, we do require additional help to run the races.

Catsuits for Minis if the weather is fine

The TCM will consider the weather forecast each day and decide whether or not to allow the U10/U12s to compete in catsuits. Be prepared. If the weather turns foul, Mini racers arriving at the start in catsuits will not be permitted to leave the gate.

Racers are reminded that helmets for **giant slalom** must conform to GB rules, i.e. no soft sides, soft vents, and remove slalom chin guard.

Conduct

The resort have asked that competitors ski in a safe manner on the public pistes, or with due regard for the safety and enjoyment of other hill users. In particular please slow down well before joining the lift queue. Racers caught skiing dangerously may be excluded from the races.

Keep ski-passes with you. **No ticket, no lift.**

And finally, please, no littering.
